

## Edward A. Butler. BIOGRAPHY

Philadelphia-born artist Edward Butler was the youngest student ever admitted to Philadelphia's prestigious Samuel Fleisher Art Memorial School where he began his formal art education at the age of eight. He went on to graduate from the Philadelphia College of Art before moving to New York City, where he has been painting ever since.

Edward Butler's is represented by Gallery Henoeh, NYC. His work was first publicly viewed at the New York Academy of Arts "Take Home a Nude" show, where he was invited to exhibit for several consecutive years. His work is also on display at Galerie Sono in Norwalk, CT and The Vault Gallery in Cambria, CA and has been shown at Gallery 25N in New York, D&K Fine Arts Gallery in Maryland, and New York's The National Art Club. He is represented in many private collections including works commissioned by collectors.

Today, Mr. Butler and his wife live in a restored 120-year-old brick row house in Long Island City, NY where he maintains his studio. A classically trained pianist, he also is an experienced aerobatic pilot.
